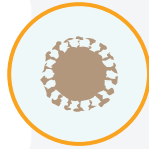

Causes of Hypoxemia

- Oxygen/Carbon dioxide exchange is blocked at the alveolar level
- Causes can be acute like aspiration
- Causes can be from something chronic such as chronic obstructive pulmonary disease
